There will be opportunities to contribute to the creative process within the team. An important part of this is keeping up with current trends and visiting exhibitions and visitor experiences. You will have the ability to share this research with the other members of the team.

Responsibilities:

- Working with and supporting the Design and Interpretation teams
- Developing designs through hand-drawn sketches, CAD drawings and computer modelling
- Creating 3D visuals and models
- Preparing reports, presentations and proposals.
- Attending client meetings and presentations
- Documenting meetings

Typical Activities:

The specific details of the role vary depending on the status of projects. These may include:

- Attending design and creative meetings, sharing ideas, taking a record of meetings.
- Producing attractive and effective designs.
- Communicating with senior team members to receive feedback.
- Liaising effectively with team members and external colleagues.
- Supporting the team throughout the execution of design for delivery.
- Procuring materials and samples and preparing these for presentation.
- Assisting with the production and collation of design reports and presentations for client submission.

Skills Required:

- Adeptness with leading design software packages
- Some creative industry experience
- Good organisational skills that support the rest of the design team
- The ability to work with the team to meet tight and demanding deadlines
- The ability to carry out targeted design-related research
- The motivation to maintain and improve design standards and progress personally
- Consistency in the quality of delivery
